






Figure 3: Percentage Distribution of Population (15 years and over) in Nablus Governorate by Labor Force Components, 2008

Figure 4: Percentage Distribution of Population(15 years and over) in Nablus Governorate by Labor Force Status, 2003-2008






Figure 5: Number of Schools in Nablus Governorate by Stage and Supervising Authority, 2007/2008

Figure 6: Numbers of Students in Schools in Nablus Governorate by Stage and Supervising Authority, 2007/2008






Figure 7: Distribution of Primary Health Care Clinics and Centers in Nablus Governorate by Supervising Authority, 2004-2008





Figure 8: Cultivated Areas of Field Crops, Fruit Trees and Vegetables in Nablus **Governorate**, 2006/2007





Figure 9: Value of Livestock Production in Nablus Governorate, and the West Bank (1000 US \$), 2006/2007



Figure 10: Percentage Distribution of Households by Type of Housing Unit in Nablus Governorate 1997,2007






Figure 11: Issued Building Licenses in Nablus Governorate by Quarter, 2008

Figure 12: Issued Building Licenses in Nablus Governorate by Area & Quarter, 2008





Executive Summary

PCBS presents this periodic statistical report about the reality of the Palestinian population in Nablus governorate as part of displaying facts about the Palestinian populations in the Palestinian governorates. These are the most prominent findings:

- The population in Nablus governorate totaled 332,389 by mid 2009 including 168,189 males and 164,200 females. The percentage of refugees living in Nablus governorate totaled 26.3% of the total population of the governorate end year 2007.
- The number of registered marriage certificates at Shariah and church courts during 2008 in Nablus governorate totaled 2,822. The number of registered divorce cases at Shariah and church courts totaled 433.
- The number registered live births in 2008 in Nablus governorate totaled 9,018. The number of registered deaths in the governorate for the same year totaled 1,000.
- The Participation Rate of labor force (aged 15+) in 2008 in Nablus governorate is 41.9%. Findings showed that the percentage of unemployed people among those participating labor force was 15.6%.
- The number of schools and kindergartens in Nablus governorate in 2007 2008 was 252 schools and 115 kindergartens.
- The number of hospitals in 2008 in Nablus governorate was 6 hospitals. Number of hospital beds totaled 520 at 1.6 per 1000 people.
- The area of lands in Nablus governorate in 2007 was 605 square kilometers.
- 201,259 dunums of trees cultivated land at a production capacity of 14,247 tons. The area planted with field crops totaled 35,145 dunums producing 11,956 tons and the area planted with vegetables totaled 5,686 dunums producing 15,852 tons in Agricultural year 2006/2007.
- The number of occupied houses in Nablus governorate totaled 58,750 in 2007.
- The number of building licenses in Nablus governorate in 2008 totaled 1,058 for an area of 309,700 square meters.
- The number of localities in Nablus governorate in 2008 according to the main source of water networks is 40 localities, and 24 localities without water network. Electricity network was the main source for 64 localities.
- The number of licensed vehicles in 2008 in Nablus & Salfit governorates was 16,829.
- The number of hotels in 2008 in Nablus governorate totaled 6.
- The values of imports rose in Nablus & Salfit governorates in 2007 compared to 2003–2006, reaching 408.8 million US\$.
- Exports in Nablus & Salfit governorates in 2007 rose, in comparison with 2003–2006, reaching 65.9 million US\$.
- There was deficit in the trade balance of Nablus & Salfit governorates in 2007 totaling 342.9 million US\$.
