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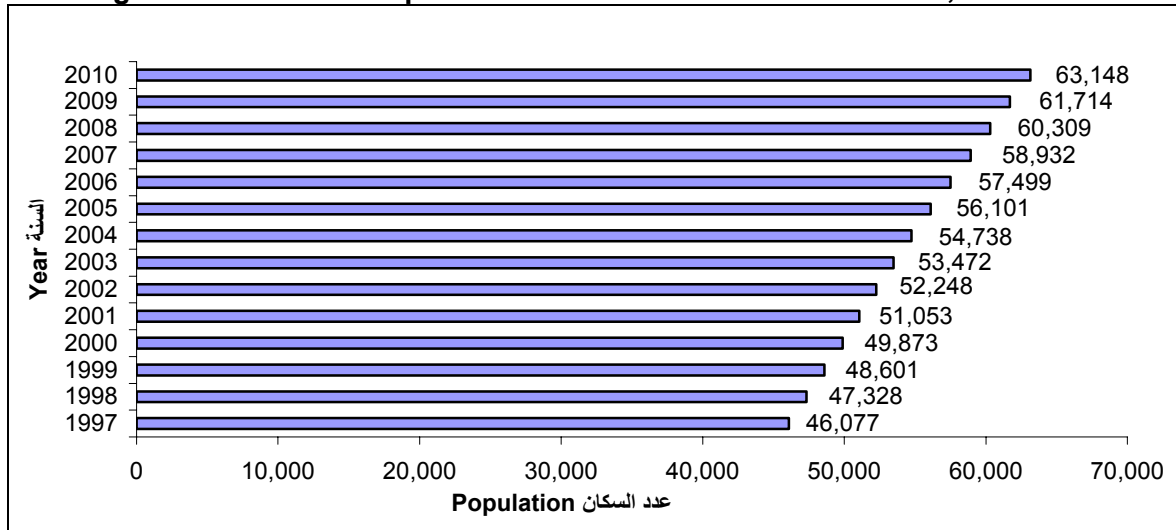

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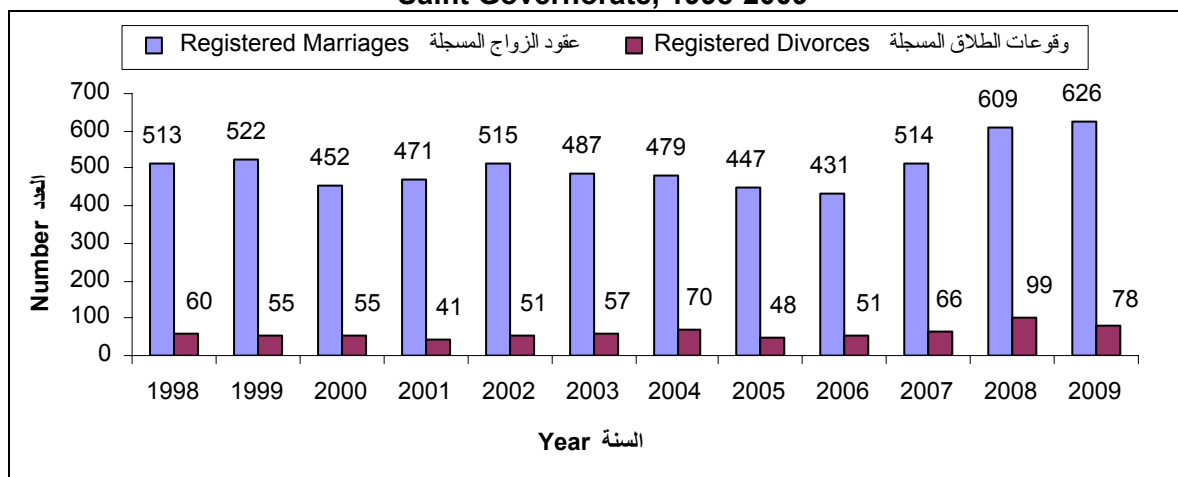

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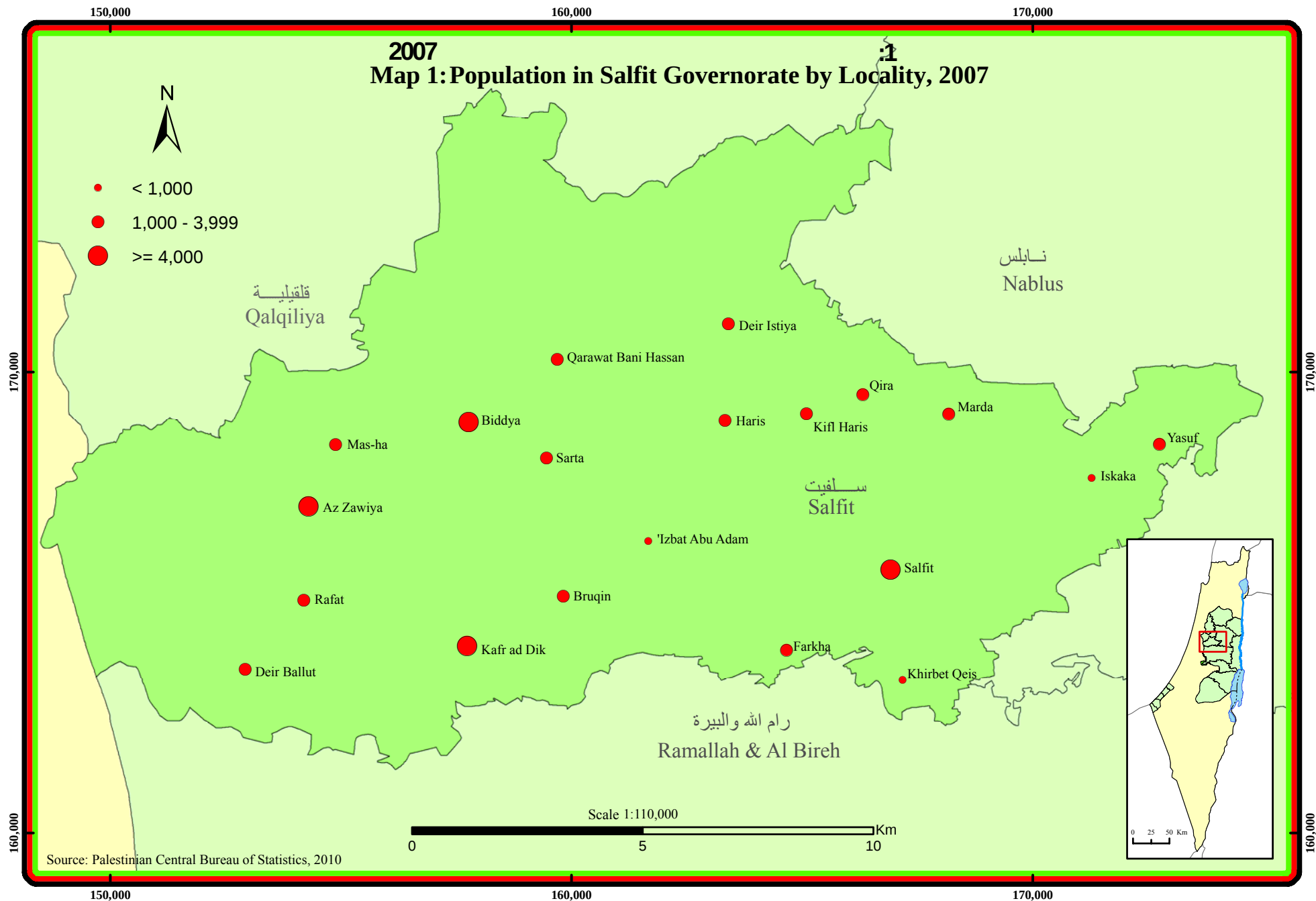

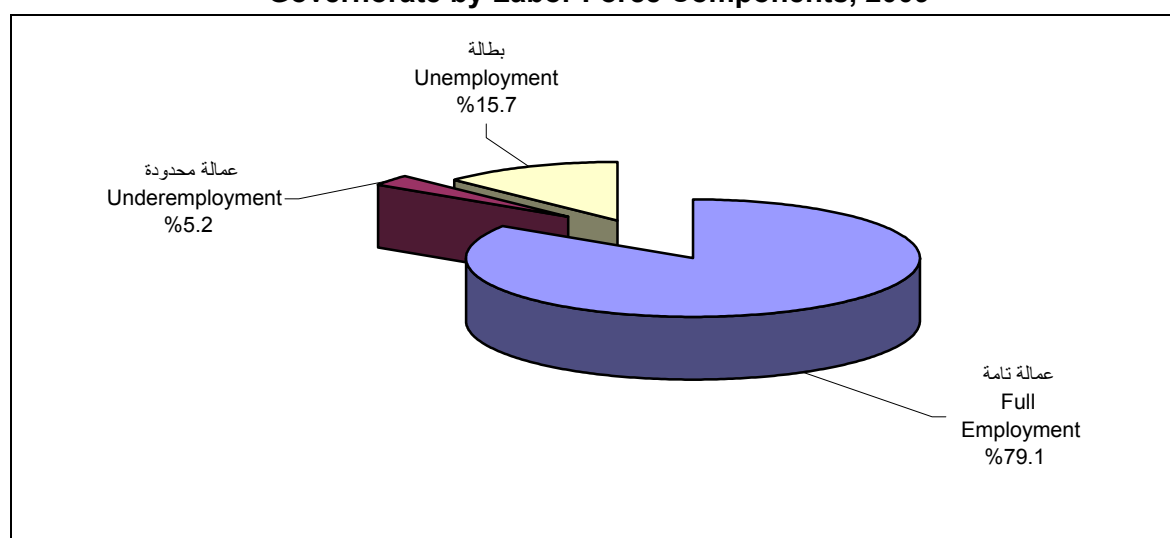

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Figure 4: Percentage Distribution of Population (15 years and over) in Salfit Governorate by Labor Force Components, 2009

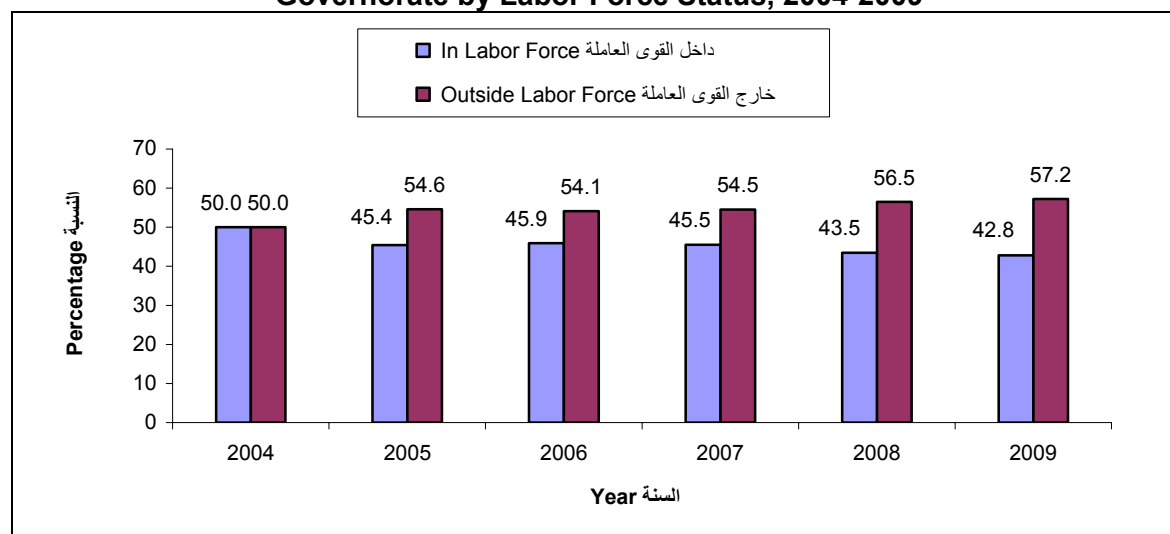


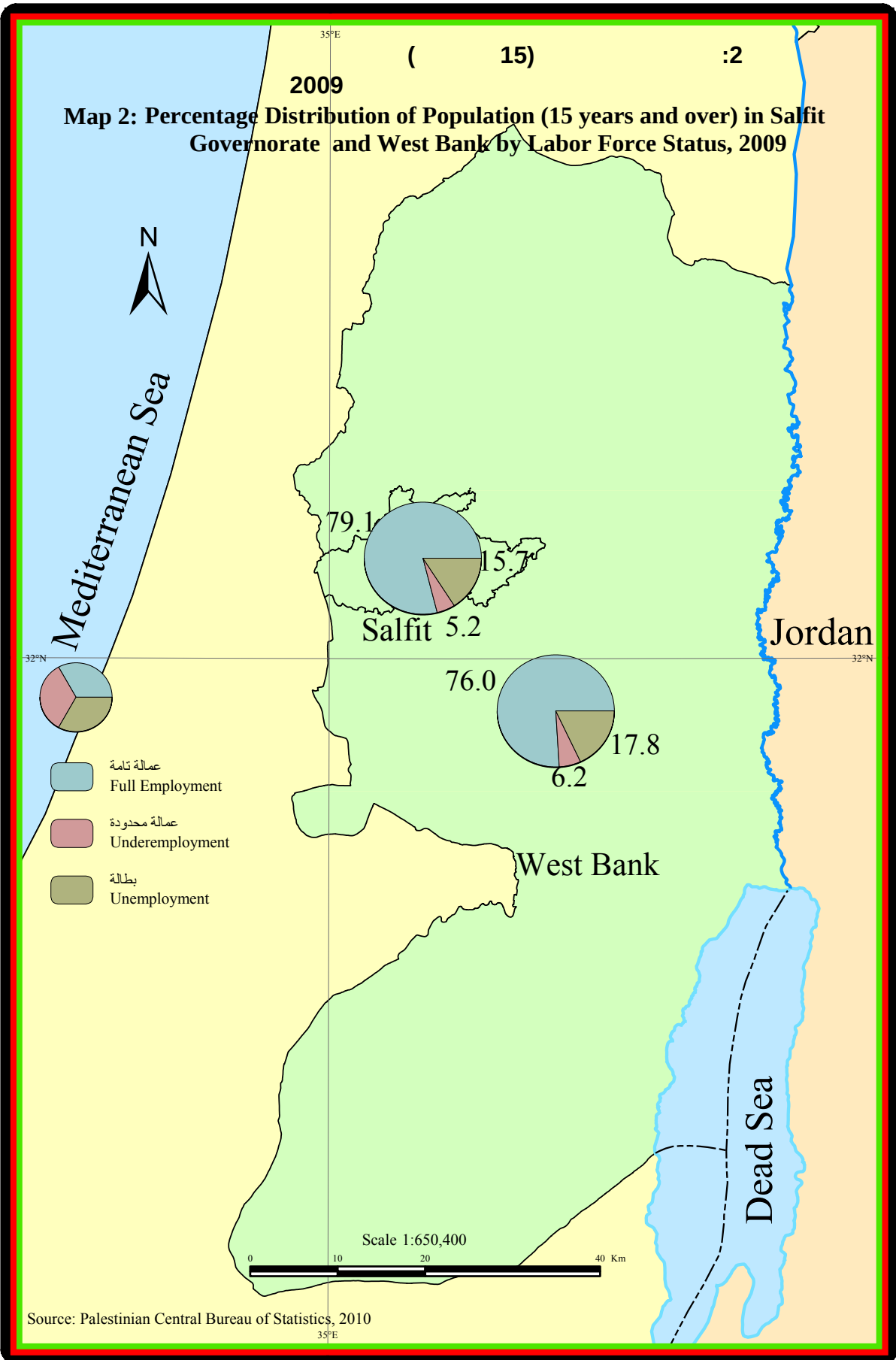

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Figure 5: Percentage Distribution of Population (15 years and over) in Salfit Governorate by Labor Force Status, 2004-2009





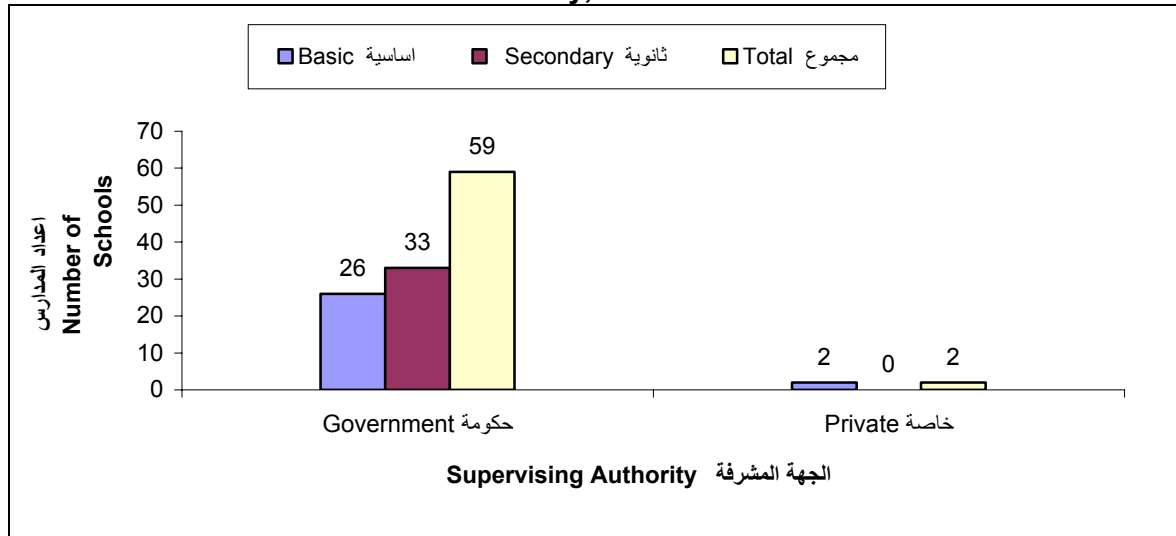

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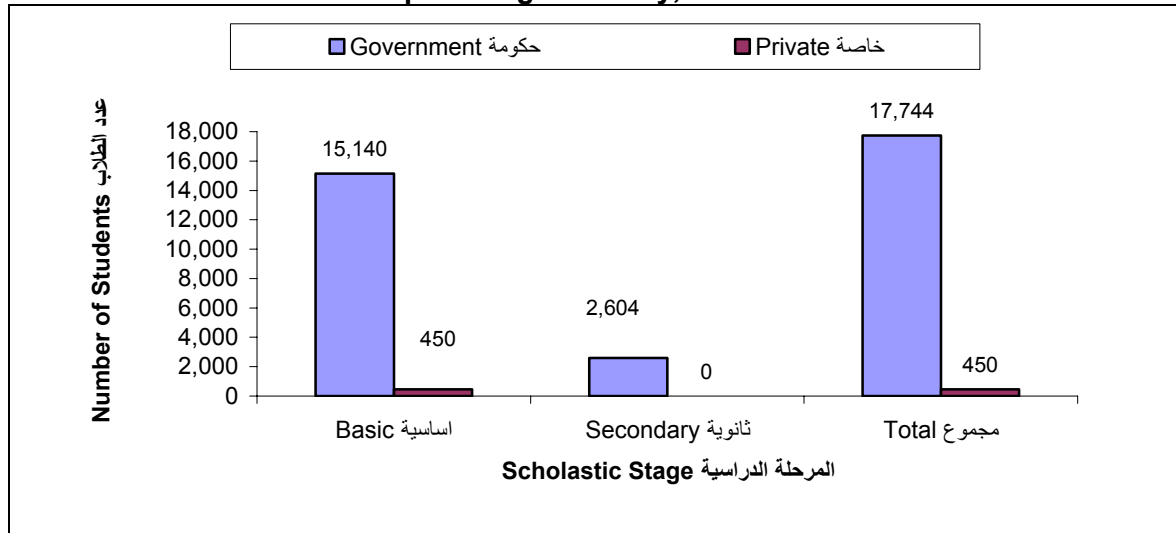
Figure 6: Number of Schools in Salfit Governorate by Stage and Supervising Authority, 2008/2009

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Figure 7: Numbers of Students in Schools in Salfit Governorate by Stage and Supervising Authority, 2008/2009



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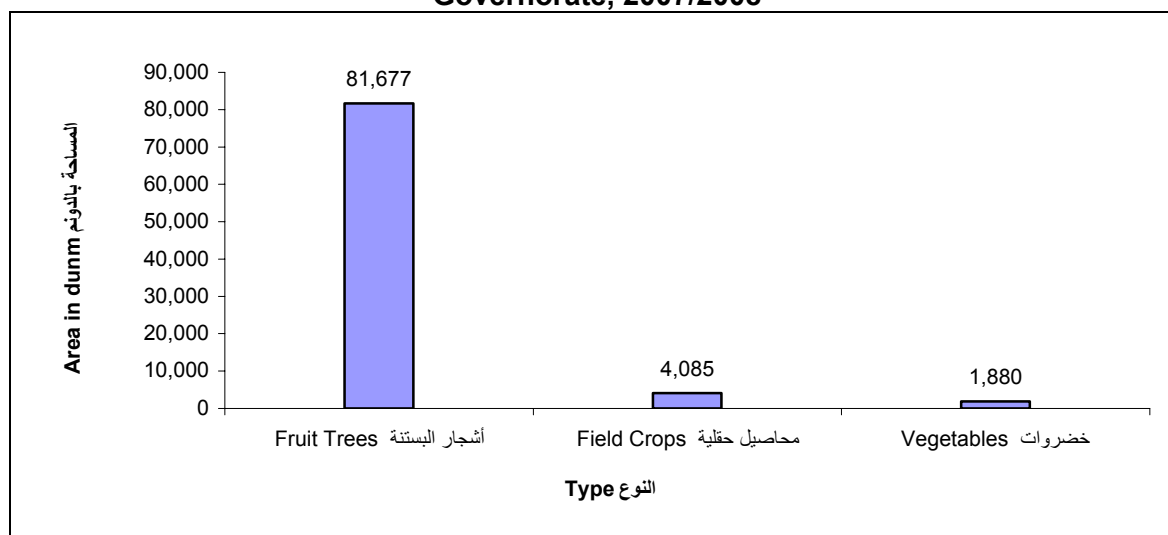

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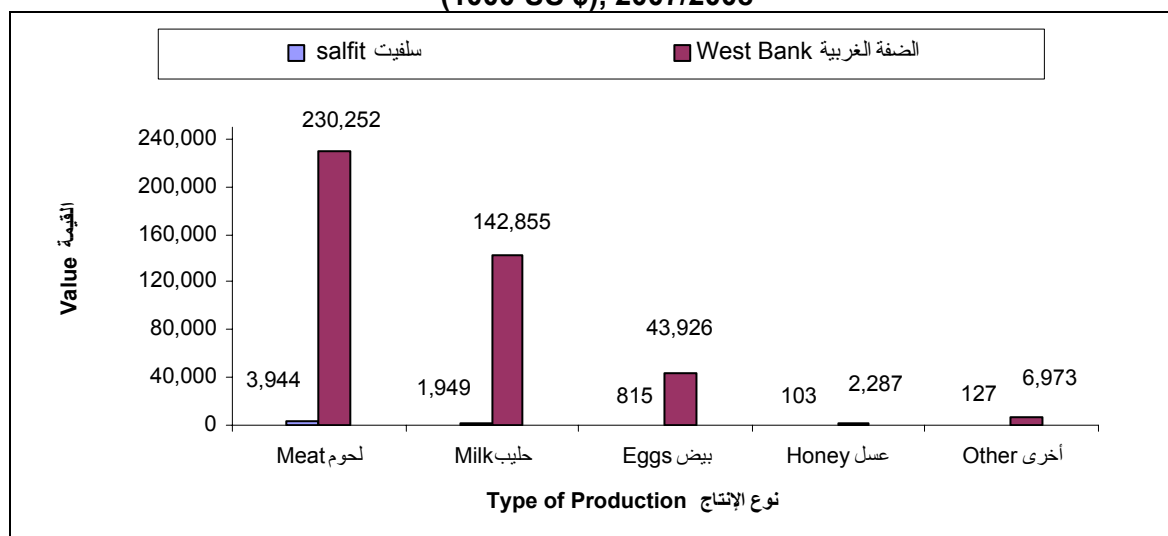
Figure 8: Cultivated Areas of Field Crops, Fruit Trees and Vegetables in Salfit Governorate, 2007/2008

Figure 9: Value of Livestock Production in Salfit Governorate, and the West Bank (1000 US \$), 2007/2008

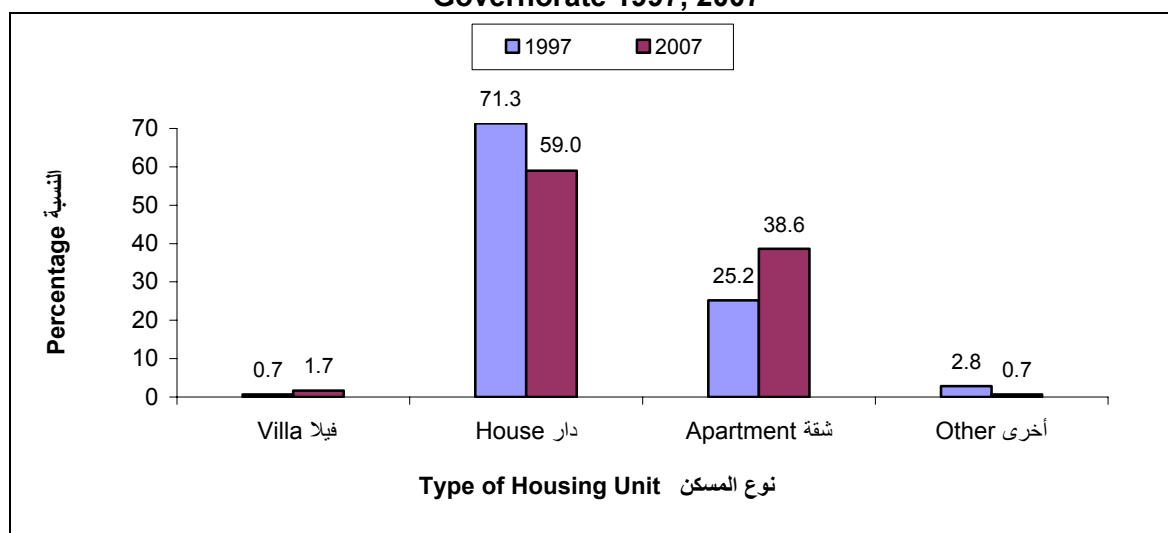

Figure 10: Percentage Distribution of Households by Type of Housing Unit in Salfit Governorate 1997, 2007

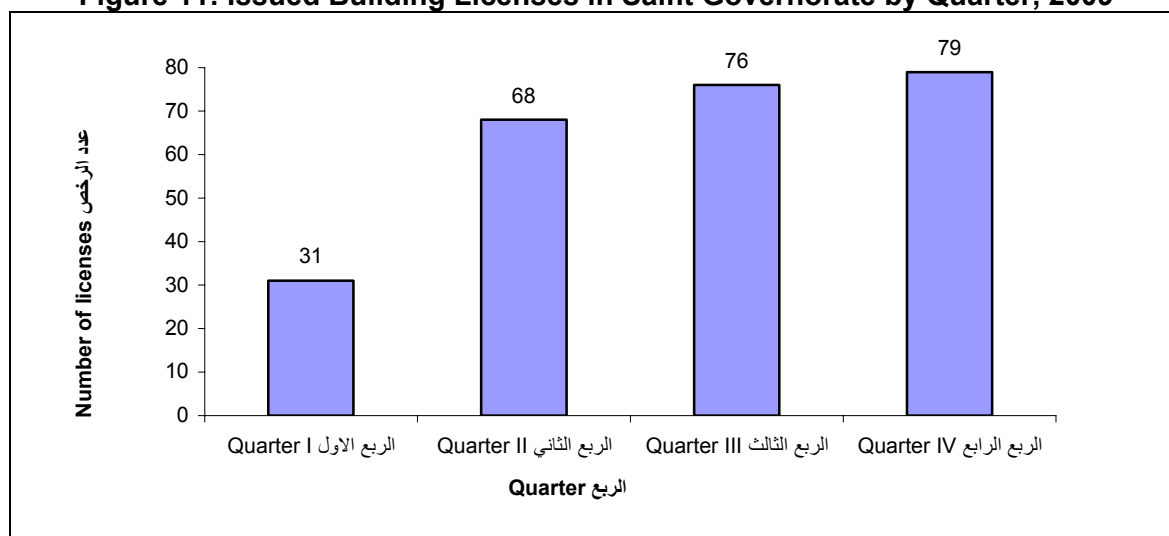

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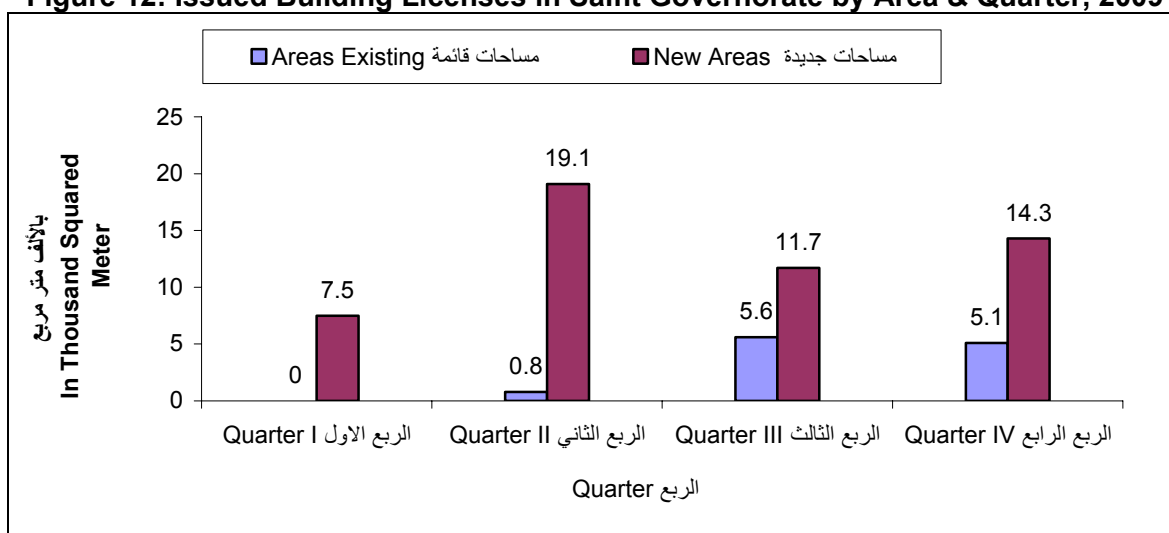
Figure 11: Issued Building Licenses in Salfit Governorate by Quarter, 2009

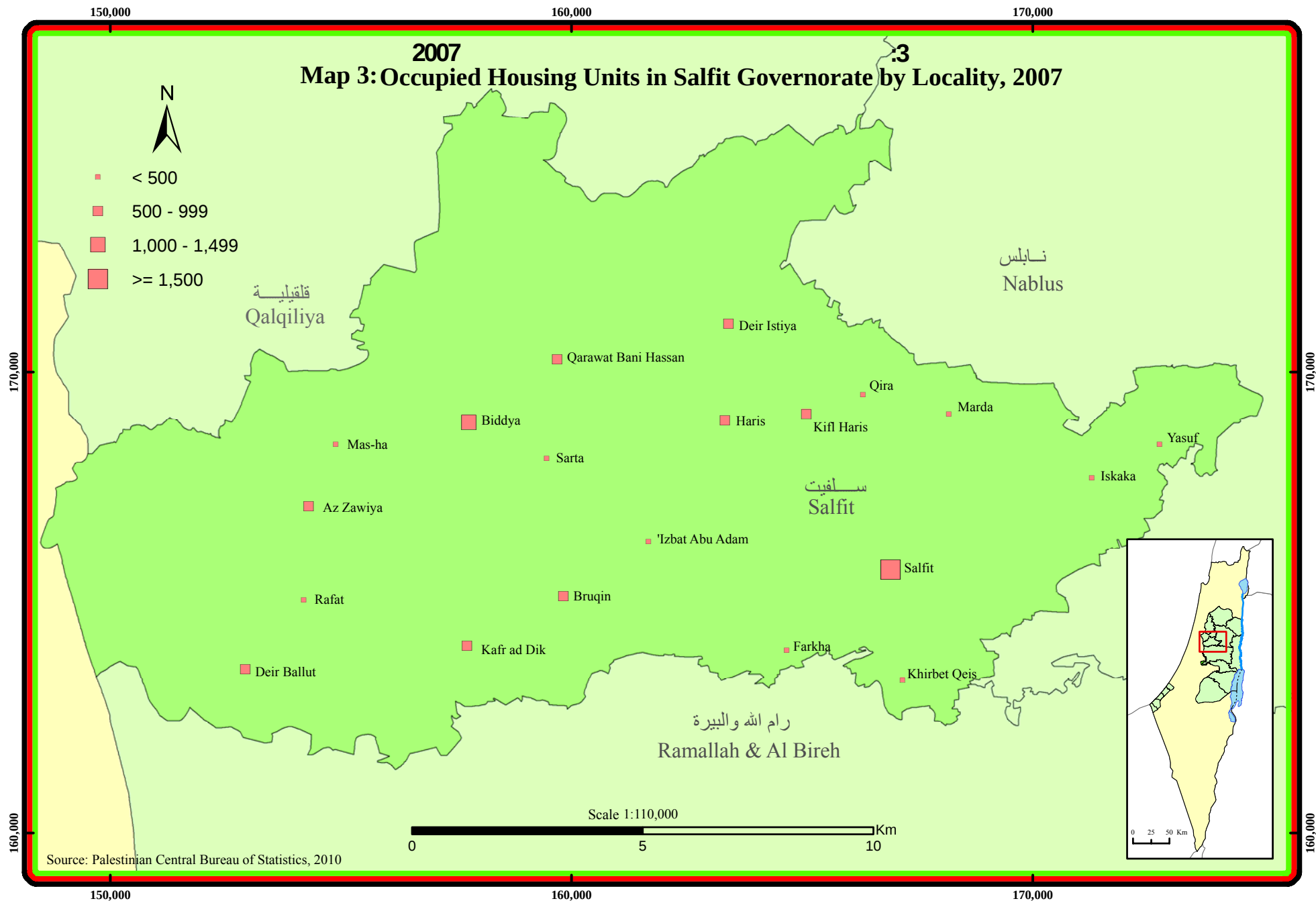


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Figure 12: Issued Building Licenses in Salfit Governorate by Area & Quarter, 2009





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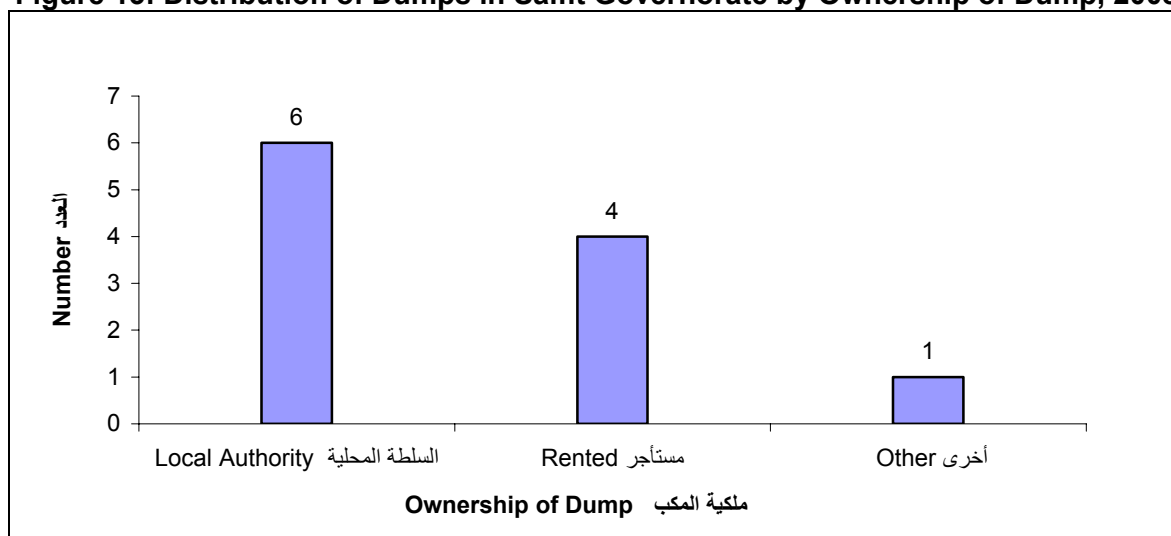
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Figure 13: Distribution of Dumps in Salfit Governorate by Ownership of Dump, 2008



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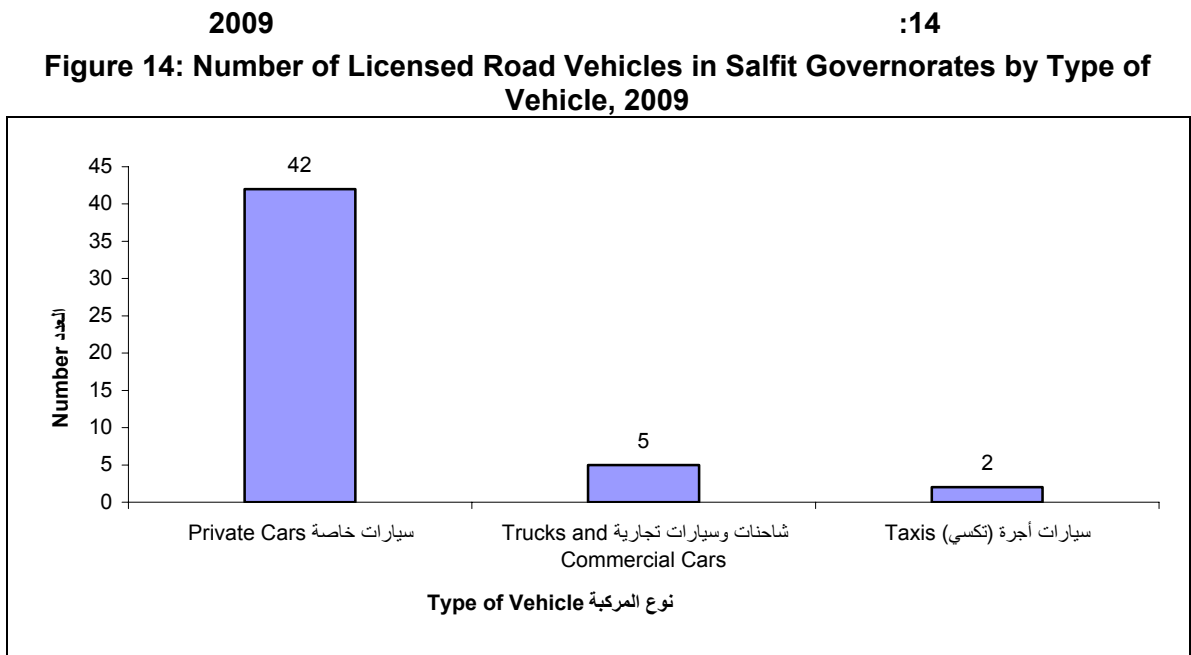

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Executive Summary

PCBS presents this periodic statistical report about the reality of the Palestinian population in Salfit governorate as part of displaying facts about the Palestinian populations in the Palestinian governorates. These are the most prominent findings:

- The population in Salfit governorate totaled 63,148 by mid 2010 including 32,079 males and 31,069 females. The percentage of refugees living in Nablus governorate totaled 8.3% of the total population of the governorate end year 2007.
- The number of registered marriage certificates at Shariah and church courts during 2009 in Salfit governorate totaled 626. The number of registered divorce cases at Shariah and church courts totaled 78.
- The number registered live births in 2009 in Salfit governorate totaled 2,010. The number of registered deaths in the governorate for the same year totaled 219.
- The number of hospitals in 2009 in Salfit governorate was one hospital. Number of hospital beds totaled 49 at 0.8 per 1000 people.
- The Participation Rate of labor force (aged 15+) in 2009 in Salfit governorate is 42.8%. Findings showed that the percentage of unemployed people among those participating labor force was 15.7%.
- The number of schools and kindergartens in Salfit governorate in 2008/2009 was 61 schools and 16 kindergartens.
- The area of lands in Salfit governorate in 2008 was 204 square kilometers.
- 81,677 dunums of trees cultivated land at a production capacity of 9,431 tons. The area planted with field crops totaled 4,085 dunums producing 576 tons and the area planted with vegetables totaled 1,880 dunums producing 3,126 tons in Agricultural year 2007/2008.
- The number of occupied houses in Salfit governorate totaled 10,958 in 2007.
- The number of building licenses in Salfit governorate in 2009 totaled 254 for an area of 64.1 Thousand square meters.
- The number of localities in Salfit governorate in 2008 according to the main source of water networks is 18 localities, and 2 localities without water network. Electricity network was the main source for 20 localities.
- The number of licensed vehicles in 2009 in Salfit governorates was 49.
- The values of imports rose in Nablus & Salfit governorates in 2008 by 11.0% compared to 2004–2007, reaching 453.8 million US\$.
- Exports in Nablus & Salfit governorates in 2008 rose by 45.4%, in comparison with 2004–2007, reaching 95.8 million US\$.
- There was deficit in the trade balance of Nablus & Salfit governorates in 2008 totaling 358.0 million US\$.

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
