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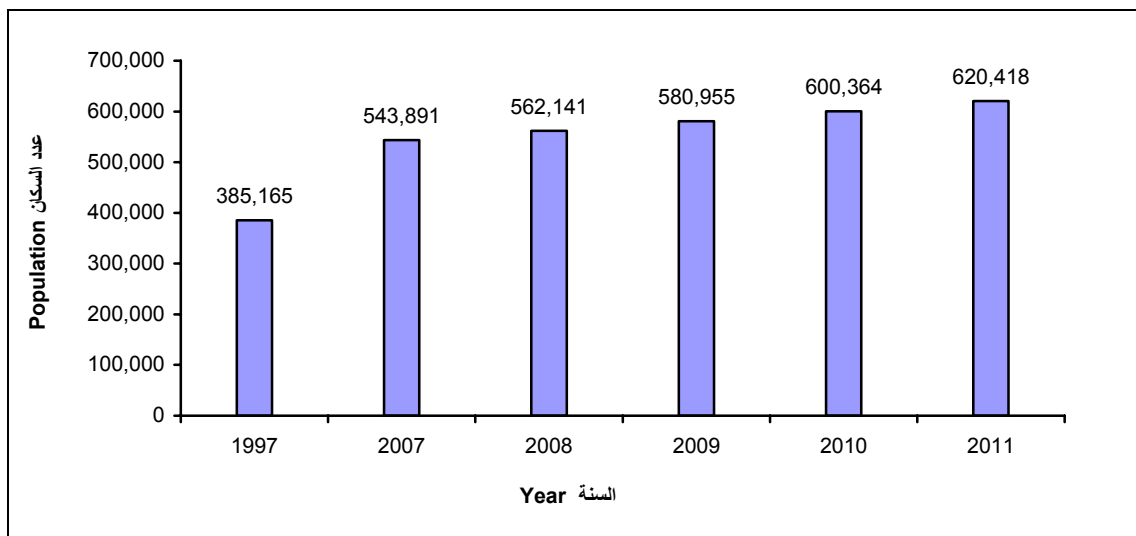

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Figure 1: Estimated Population in Hebron Governorate at Mid-Year, 1997, 2007-2011



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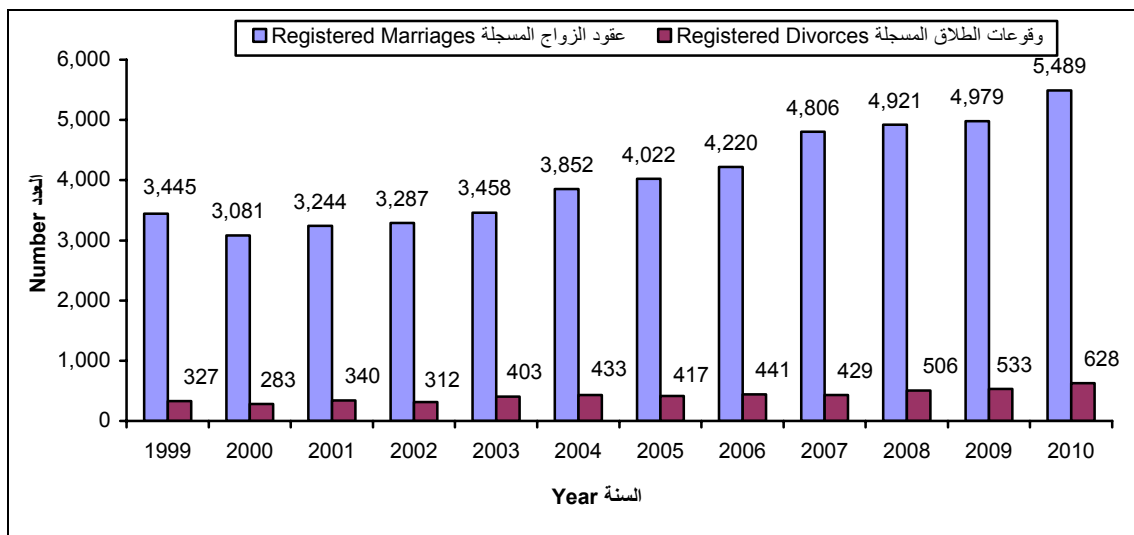

Figure 2: Number of Registered Marriages and Divorces in Shariah and Church Courts in Hebron Governorate, 1999-2010



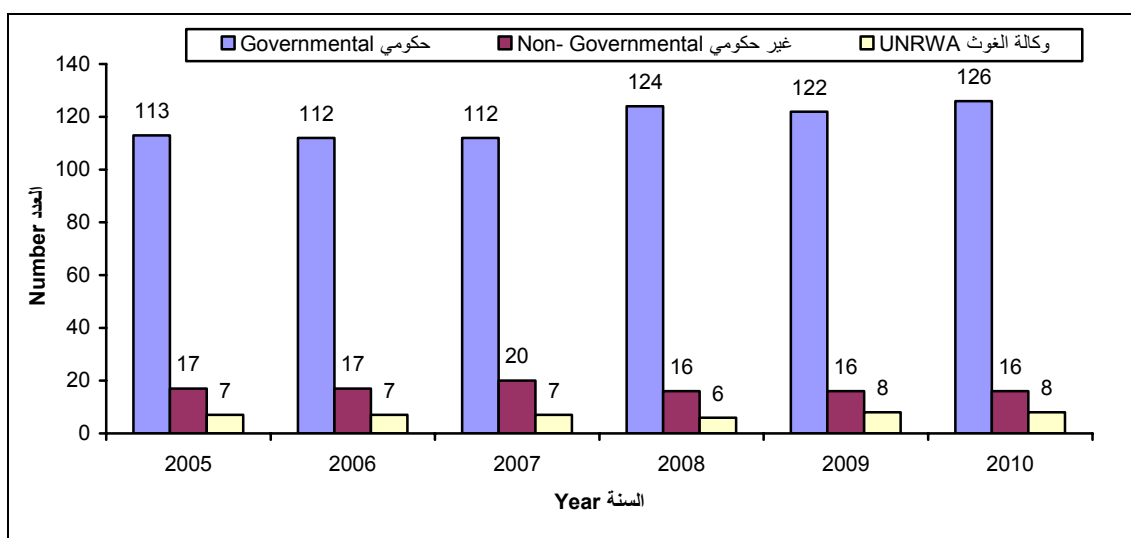

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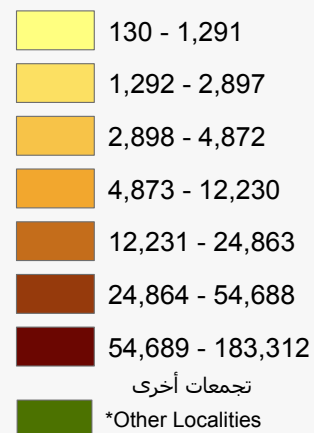

Figure 3: Number of Primary Health Care Clinics and Centers in Hebron Governorate by Supervising Authority, 2005-2010



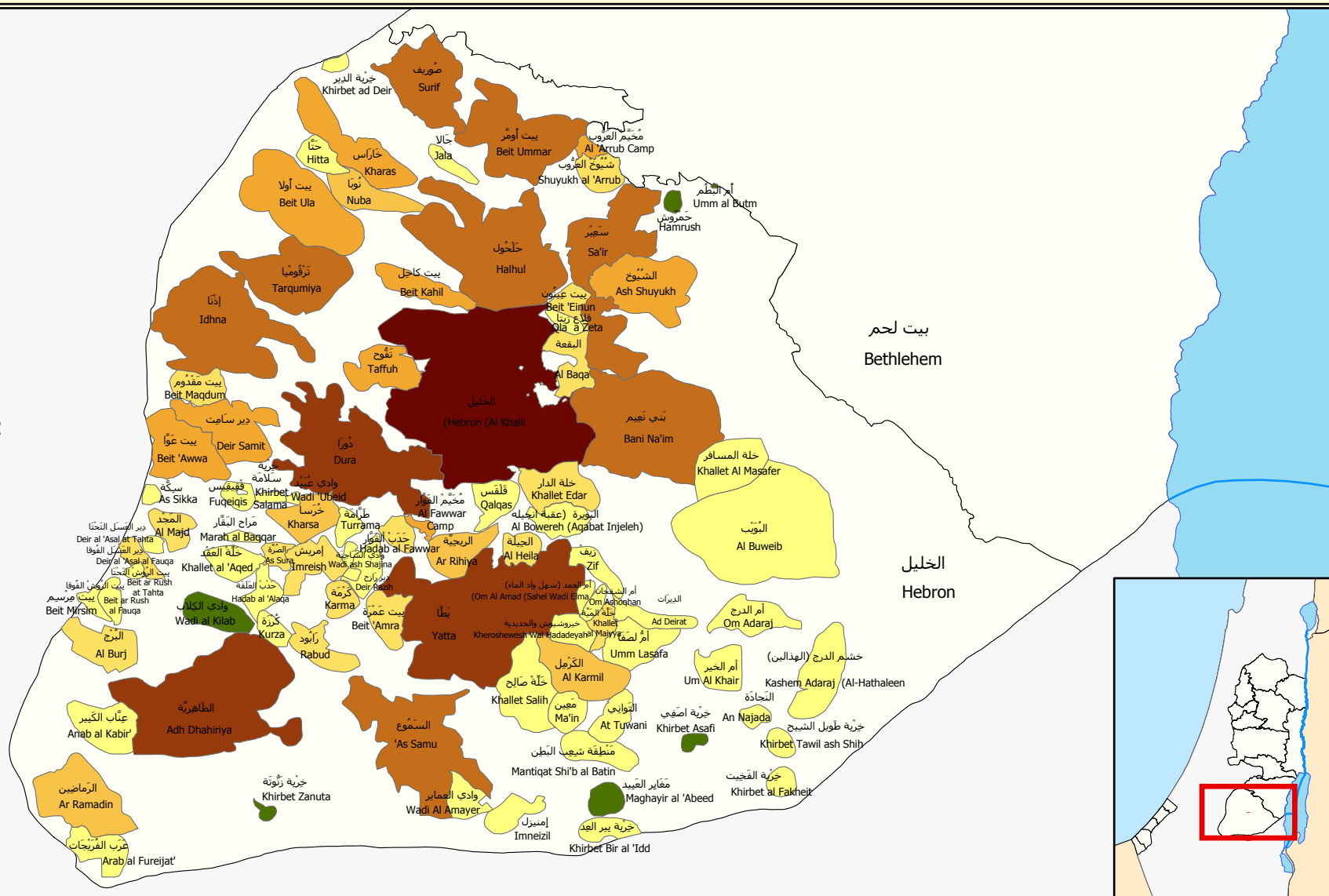

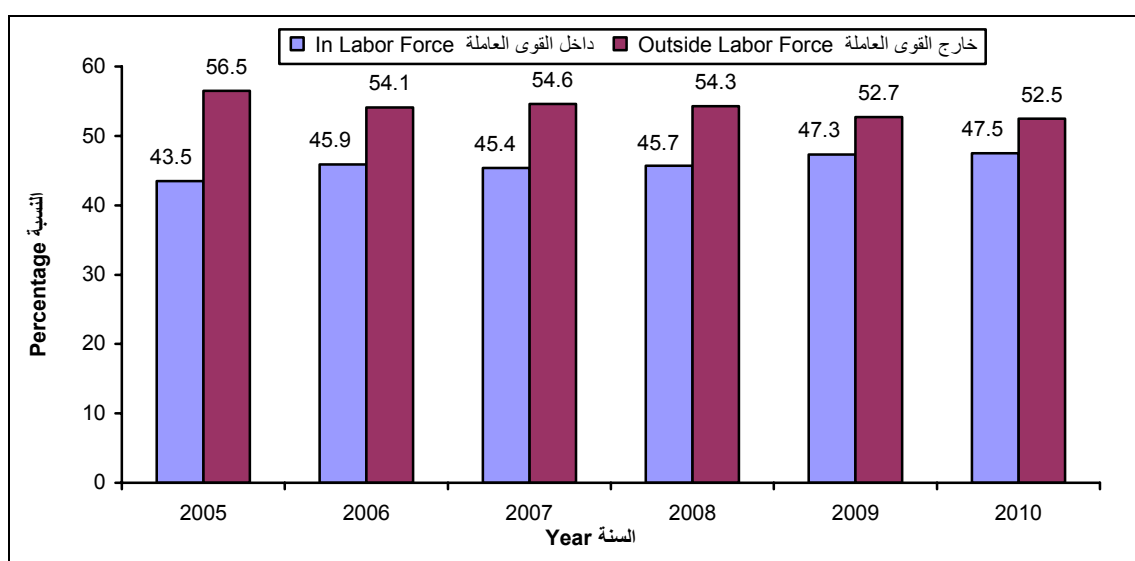

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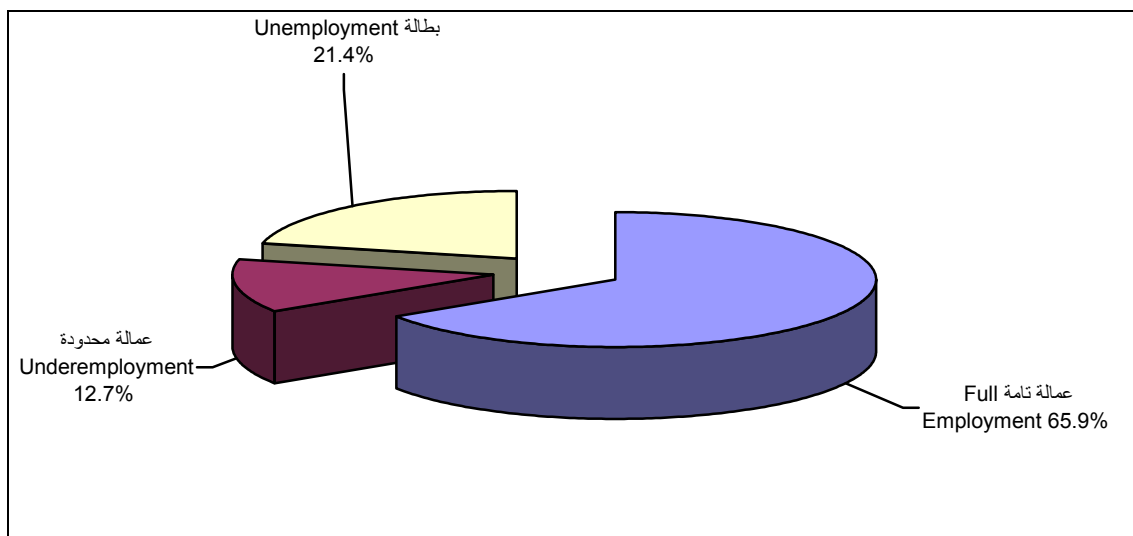

Figure 5: Percentage Distribution of Population (15 Years and Above) in Hebron Governorate by Labor Force Components, 2010

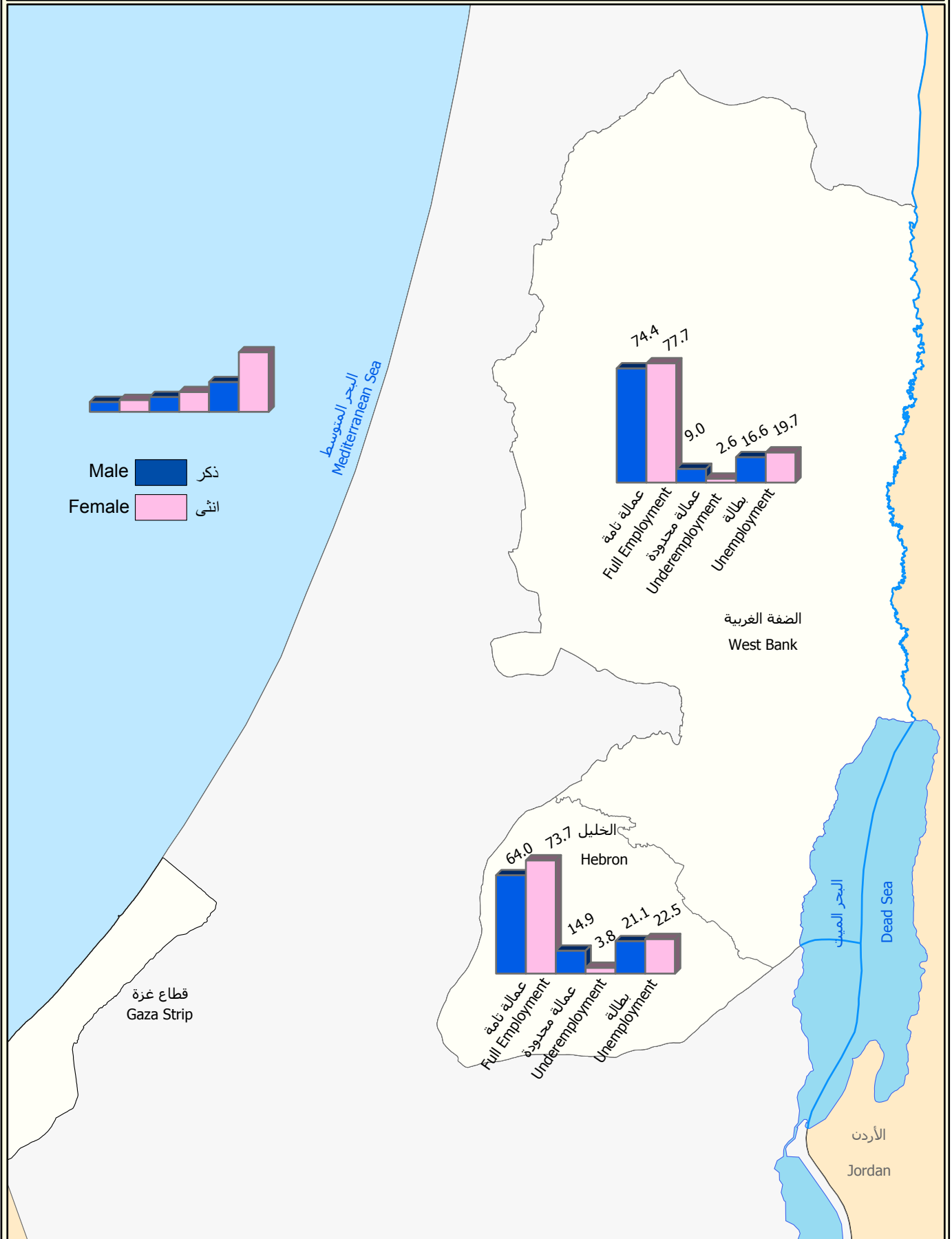

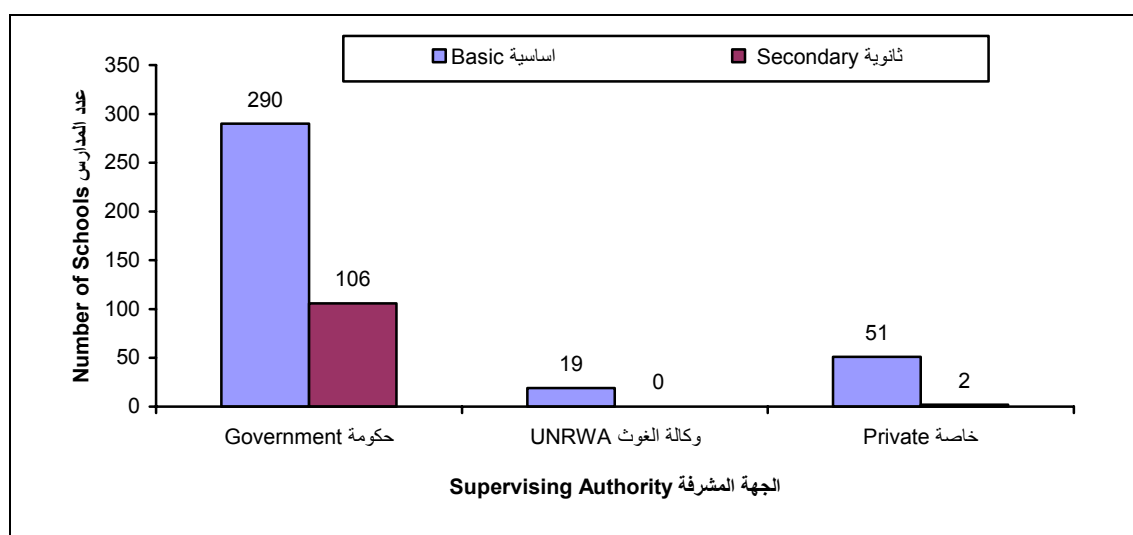

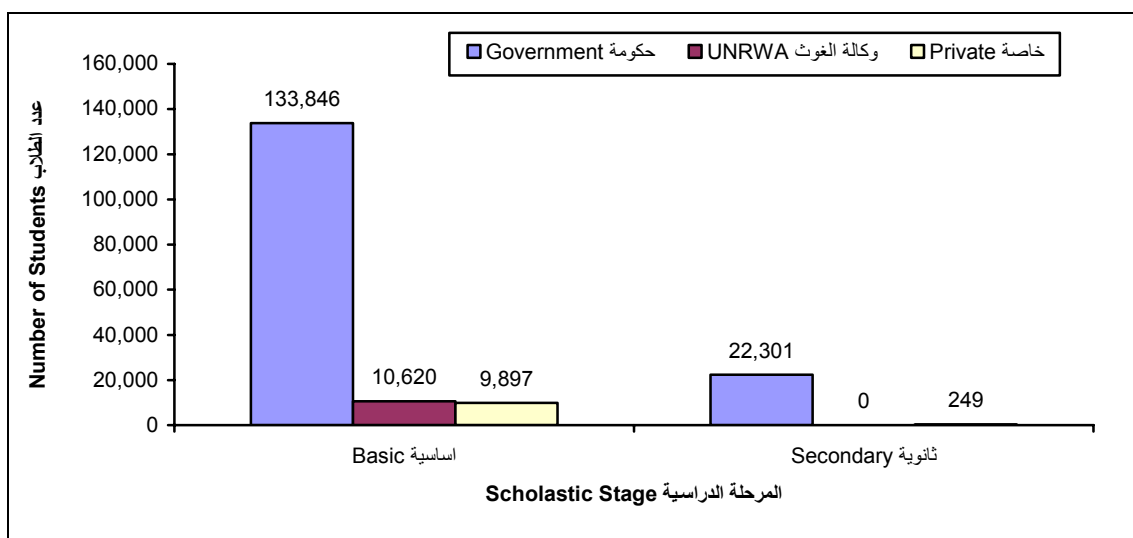
Figure 6: Number of Schools in Hebron Governorate by Stage and Supervising Authority, 2010/2011

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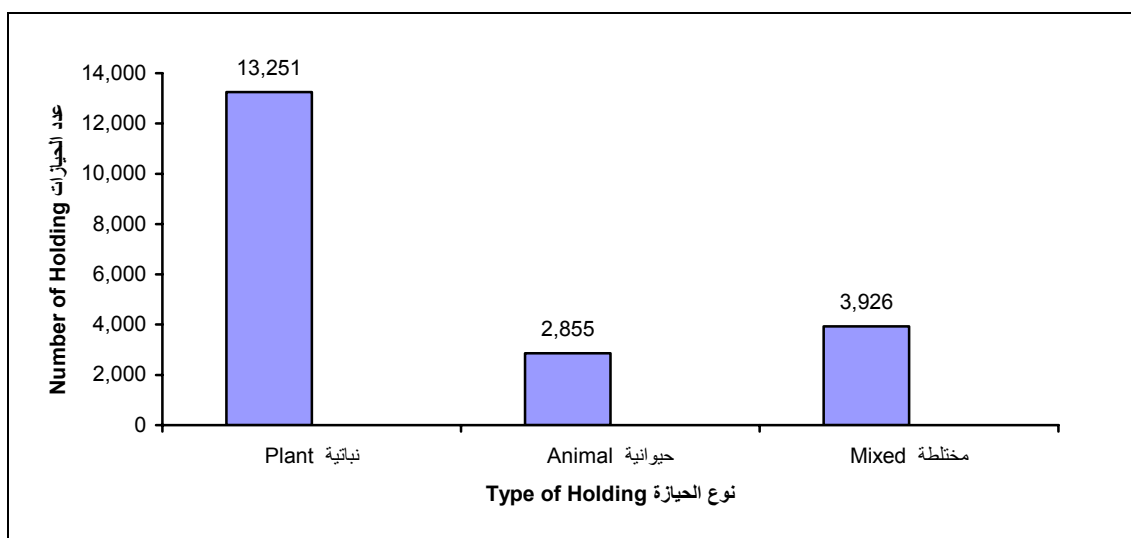

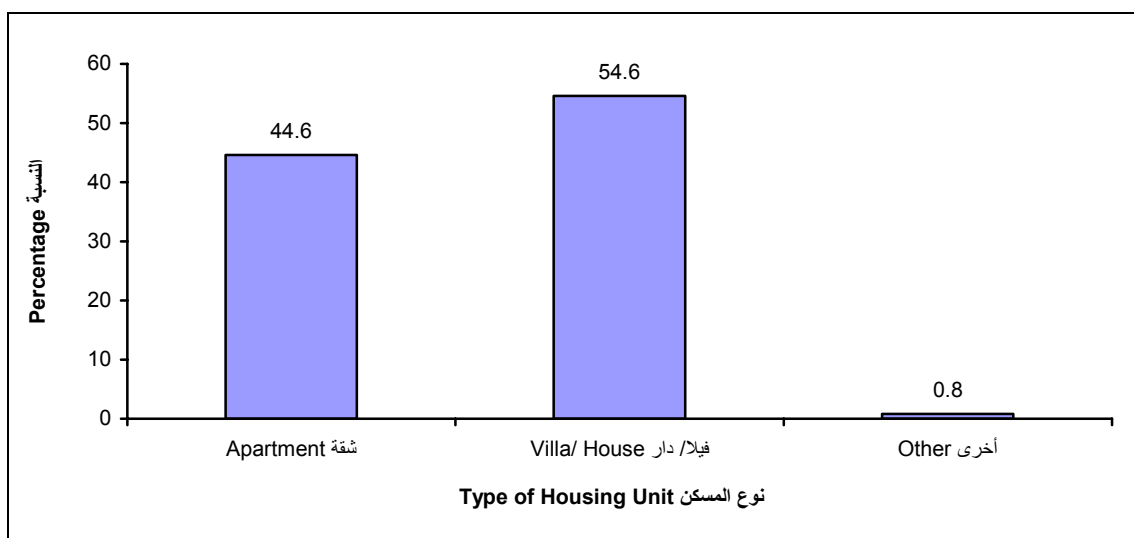

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Figure 9: Percentage Distribution of Households in Hebron Governorate by Type of Housing Unit, 2010



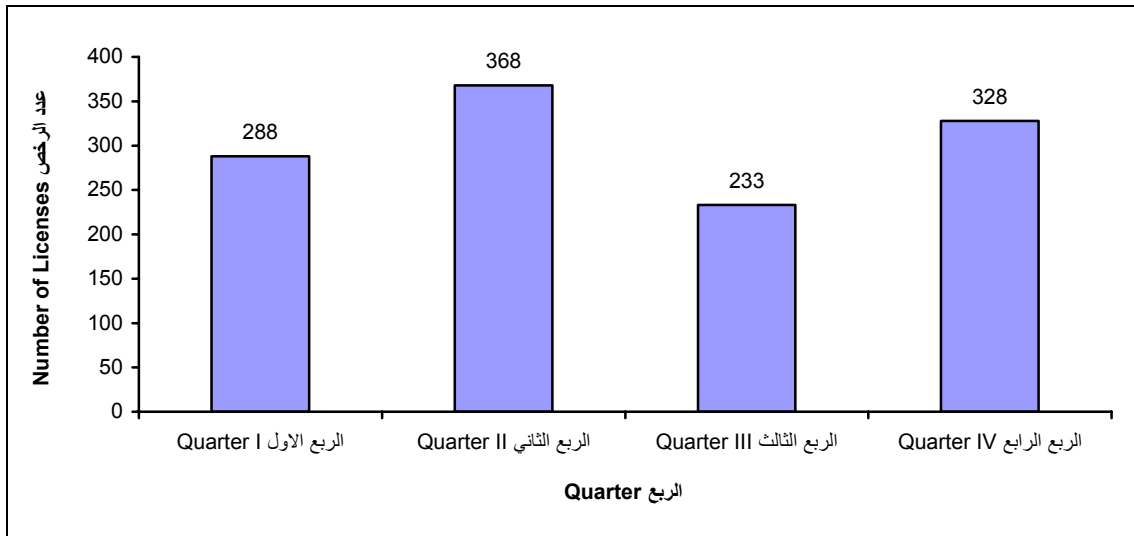

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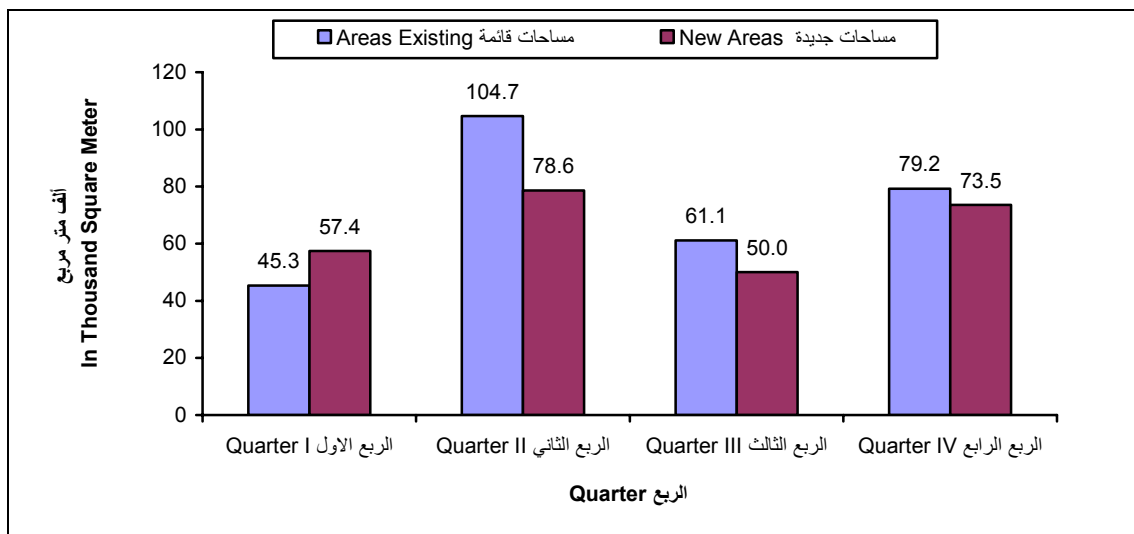
Figure 10: Number of Issued Building Licenses in Hebron Governorate by Quarter, 2010

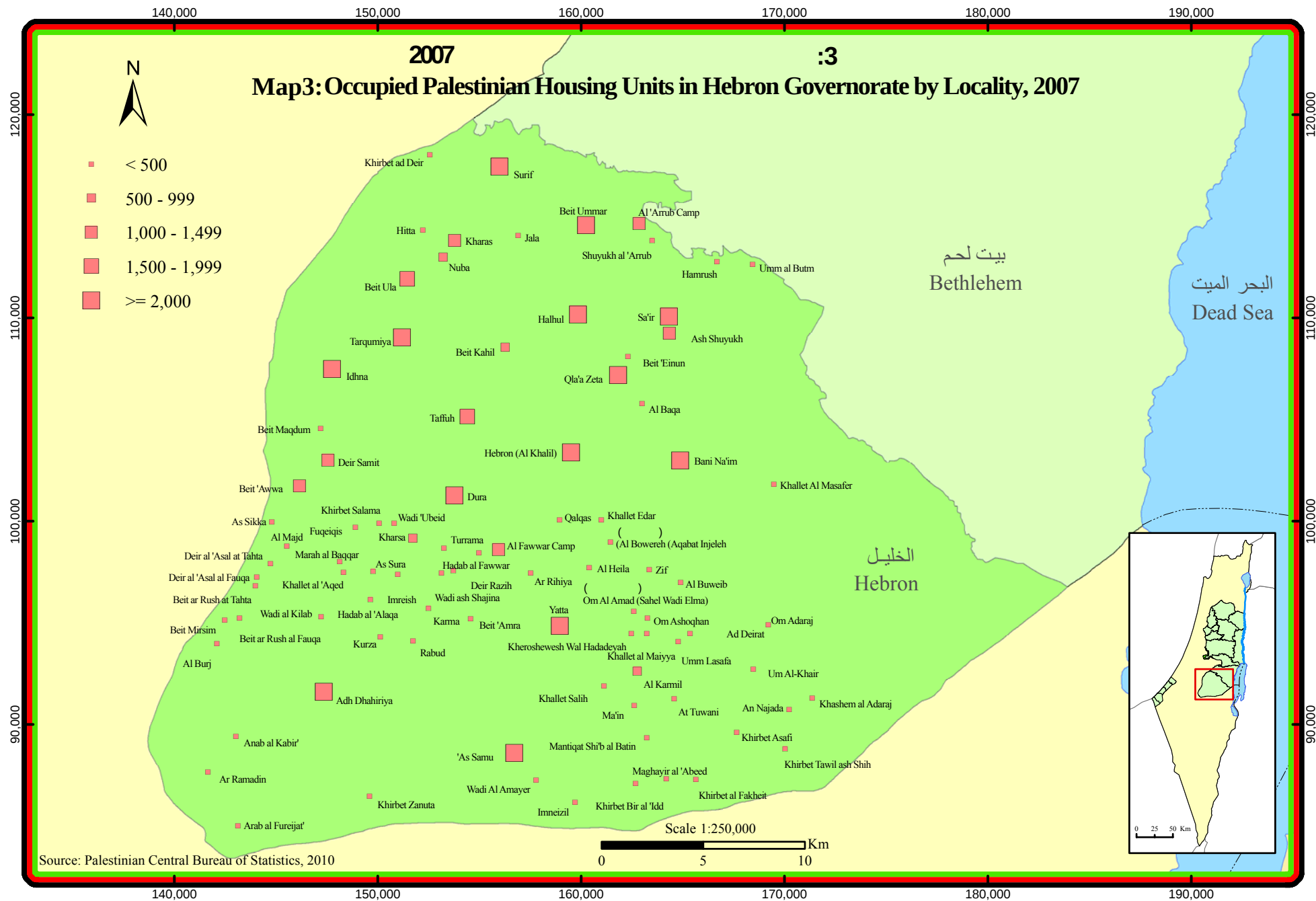

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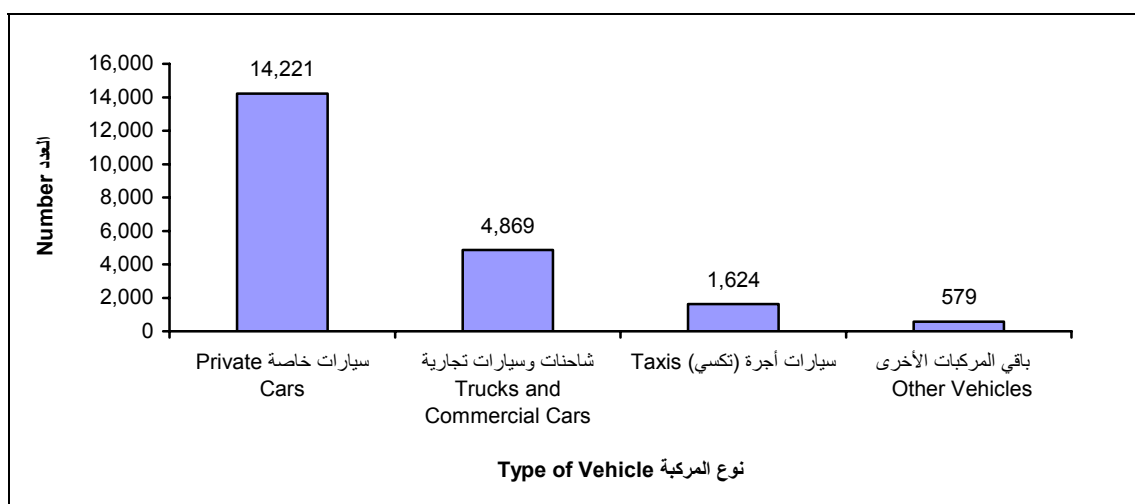

Executive Summary

PCBS presents this periodic statistical report about the reality of the Palestinian population in Hebron governorate as part of its policy to shed light on the status of Palestinian population in the different governorates in the Palestinian Territory. These are the most prominent findings:

- Estimated population in Hebron governorate totaled 620,418 person at mid 2011 including 316,413 males and 304,005 females. About 17.9% of the total population of Hebron governorate are refugees at year 2007.
- Number of registered marriage certificates at shariah and church courts during 2010 in Hebron governorate totaled 5,489. The number of registered divorce cases at Shariah and courts totaled 628.
- Number of registered live births in 2010 in Hebron governorate totaled 19,598 birth. Number of registered deaths in the governorate for the same year totaled 1,316.
- Number of hospitals in 2010 in Hebron governorate was 9 hospitals. Number of hospital beds totaled 532 with bed occupancy rate of 0.9 per 1000 people.
- The participation rate of labor force (aged 15 years and above) in 2010 in Hebron governorate was 47.5% from total of human power. Unemployed persons constitute about 21.4% of those participating in labor force.
- 32.5% of the individuals are poor in Hebron governorate in 2010.
- There were 468 schools and 185 kindergartens in Hebron governorate in 2010/2011.
- The area of lands in Hebron governorate in 2010 was 997 square kilometers.
- Number of agricultural holdings in Hebron governorate reached 20,032 during the agricultural year 2009/2010.
- Number of building licenses in Hebron governorate in 2010 totaled 1,217 license for an area of 549.6 thousand square meters.
- Water networks are main source of water for 52 localities in Hebron governorate compared with 40 localities without water network. Electricity network are main source of electricity for 81 localities.
- Number of licensed vehicles in 2010 in Hebron governorate was 21,293 vehicle.
- The values of imports increased in Hebron and governorate in 2009 compared to 2008, reaching about 692.7 million US\$.
- Exports in Hebron governorate in 2009 decreased, in comparison with year 2008, reaching 172.7 million US\$.
- There was deficit in the trade balance of Hebron governorate in 2009 totaling 520 million US\$.

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
