





Introduction

Tourism is considered to be a cornerstone of the Palestinian economy and there are many attractive tourist sites for people of all interests. PCBS has collected statistical data on tourism and hotel activities through a continuous and thorough monthly survey since 1996, in accordance with the recommendations of the World Tourism Organization and European Union. The survey aims to produce a comprehensive database and time series of basic indicators on the hotel industry to enable the development and promotion of the tourism industry in the State of Palestine.

This report addresses the main indicators of the hotel industry. These indicators include the number of hotels in operation, the number of rooms and beds, public facilities in the surveyed hotels, the number of employees in hotels, the number of guest nights in the reference period, the number of guests by nationality, and bed and room occupancy rates.

PCBS is pleased to present the results of the survey on hotel activities in the West Bank of Palestine for the second quarter of 2013 as an important statistical reference. It is hoped that this information will pave the way to the development of a comprehensive tourism program in line with international standards and user needs.

Chapter One

Main Findings

The main findings of the Hotel Activities Survey for the second quarter of 2013 show that 107 hotels operating in the West Bank responded to the June 2013 survey and have available 5,936 rooms with a total of 13,545 beds.

1.1 Hotel Capacity During June 2013

The hotels operating in the West Bank during June 2013 were distributed as follows:


- North of West Bank: 14 hotels comprising 269 rooms with 787 beds.
- Middle of West Bank: 32 hotels comprising 1,481 rooms with 3,520 beds.
- Jerusalem region: 29 hotels comprising 1,582 rooms with 3,507 beds.
- South of West Bank: 32 hotels comprising 2,604 rooms with 5,731 beds.

1.2 Room Occupancy - Second Quarter 2013

Average room occupancy in West Bank hotels was 1,539.2, representing 26.2% of the rooms available.

Room occupancy during the second quarter of 2013 was 19.3% higher than in the previous quarter and 15.9% lower than in the second quarter of 2012.

1.3 Hotel Workers - Second Quarter 2013


There were 2,793 hotel workers: 2,121 males and 672 females. There were 542 workers in hotel administration: 379 males and 163 females. There were 2,251 workers in hotel services: 1,742 males and 509 females.

1.4 Guest and Night Occupancy - Second Quarter 2013

Guests in West Bank hotels totaled 153,085: 8.6% were Palestinian and 38.7% were from European Union countries. The number of guests fell by 3.2% compared to the second quarter of 2012.

The total night occupancy in West Bank hotels during the second quarter of 2013 was 376,848, of which 9.5% was by Palestinian guests, 40.3% by guests from European Union countries, 13.7% by guests from Asia and 8.6% by guests from the United States and Canada.

Occupancy was distributed by region as follows: 51.7% of total nights in hotels in the South of the West Bank, 25.7% in Jerusalem, 3.7% in the North of the West Bank and 18.9% in the Middle of the West Bank.

Chapter Two

Methodology and Data Quality

2.1 Survey Objectives

By conducting this survey series, we aim to provide a regular flow of data on:

- Number of hotels in operation and the number of rooms and beds.
- Rooms and public facilities in the surveyed hotels.
- Number of hotel employees.
- Number of guest nights during the reference period.
- Number of guests by nationality.
- Bed occupancy and room occupancy rates.

2.2 Survey Questionnaire

The questionnaire was designed according to international standards and recommendations. The Higher Council for the Arab Tourist Industry and the Arab Studies Society both contributed to the questionnaire design to provide data on hotel identification, employees by type of work and sex, the number of rooms and beds, number of guests, their nationality, and room and bed occupancy.

2.3 Coverage

The frame of the survey was based on the Establishments Census conducted by PCBS in 2007. This frame undergoes continuous updating, adding newly-opened hotels and removing closed ones. Hotels which have ceased operations due to maintenance or repairs are not surveyed until they become functional again.

2.4 Field Work

The field workers recruited for the implementation of this survey were selected based on their experience in similar projects. Before being recruited, field workers undergo theoretical and practical training to enable them to carry out their duties properly. Field workers are trained in data collection, how to use the survey manual for concepts and definitions, interviewing and other tasks. Regular rounds of data collection are made to respondents, thus ensuring precision and the accuracy of data.

2.5 Office Work Activities

The completed questionnaires were delivered for office editing. Upon completion of data editing, the questionnaires underwent a process of verification and coding in accordance with the coding manuals.

2.6 Tabulation and Data Processing

After being edited, verified and coded, the data were captured electronically using a specially designed data entry program developed in accordance with pre-determined formats to fulfill all of the survey's objectives. Prior to initiating data entry, theoretical and practical training sessions were offered to data entry operators. The entered data undergoes electronic editing based on standard editing rules. In addition, random quality checks were undertaken to ensure error free data entry.

After completing data entry, editing and cleaning, statistical tables are produced according to the dissemination plan.

2.7 Data Quality

This includes ensuring:

- 1. Accuracy: the publication of reports and results on the website.
- 2. Timeliness and punctuality: the accuracy of the data in relation to the mismatch between the data and the true reality of the phenomenon in question in terms of statistical and non-statistical errors.
- 3. Temporary: This dimension refers to the period between the time reference of the data and the availability of these data for users where the improvement is temporary so that the data is published in a timely manner while maintaining a high level of accuracy.
- 4. Accessibility: Users can access the data via the website or through the public services department if more detailed information is required.
- 5. Comparability: The survey results were compared with the results of the second quarter of 2012 and the first quarter 2013.
- 6. Consistency: the methodology used in this survey based on visiting the total account units (hotels), it's Consistent with in the tourist police procedure in collecting data for the hotels visitors.
- 7. Completeness: this survey covers all the working hotels in the West Bank through the second quarter of 2013, the indicators of tourist activity were collected from all the hotels.

Comparability

By comparing the findings of this report with the previous quarterly results of the Hotel Activity Survey, the results should be logical and homogenous.

The table below presents the main indicators of hotel activities in the West Bank during the period of second quarter for the years (2010 -2013).

Response Rates:

The total number of hotels in West Bank amounted to 113 hotels, of which 108 are operating and 5 are temporarily closed, data collected for 107 hotels, and only one hotel refused to cooperate in West Bank with in the end of the second quarter of 2013.

Number of totally refused cases = 1 hotel

The percentages of non response = 1.0%

It could be noted from response averages that the percentage of response was very good at the level of West Bank.

2.8 Technical Notes

Any changes in the number of hotels, rooms and beds during the first quarter of 2013 were due to the following:

- A number of hotels were undergoing repair or maintenance and were not included in the findings presented in this report.
- Data include all establishments that conduct any type of hotel activity whether categorized or not.
- This publication disseminates indicators related to Jerusalem hotels separately from the Middle of West Bank region since Jerusalem has the largest number of hotels.
- Gaza Strip hotels are not included in this publication because of the inability of field workers there to conduct data collection.

Concepts and Definitions

This section presents the main concepts and definitions used to derive the main indicators of tourism statistics. These concepts and definitions are based on international recommendations in the field of tourism statistics, and are applied to the rest of the common subjects in the PCBS. The main concepts and definitions mentioned in this report were as follows:

Hotel:

It is defined as an accommodation establishment providing overnight lodging for the visitors in a room or unit. It should hold a number of persons exceeding that of an average single family. The establishment must be under one management, and provides various facilities and services to visitors.

Operating Hotels:

It is defined as the hotels that included in the sample frame and results, excluding the non operating hotels that are carrying out repairs or maintenance, and the hotels which didn't respond to the survey.

Number of Rooms:

It refers to the furnished rooms for the use of guests. Such rooms might be single, double, triple, or quadruple. Rooms involving more than four beds were classified under (others) in the questionnaire. As for the suite, it is usually comprised of one bedroom or more, a living room and private toilet facilities.

Available Beds and Rooms: (Indicator)

It refers to beds and rooms which are ready for use during the reference period. Rooms closed for maintenance or repairs are excluded.

Guests:

It refers to visitors staying in the hotels and using their facilities. Records of new guests are based on the number of visits regardless whether it's the same person or different.

Number of Guest Nights (Bed Occupancy): (Indicator)

Number of beds booked for hotel guests. Such beds are considered as occupied whether they were actually used or not. It is measured by guest night unit.

Room Occupancy: (Indicator)

Number of booked and paid rooms. Such rooms are considered occupied whether they were actually used or not.

Average (rooms, beds) Occupancy: (Indicator)

It is defined as the total number of occupied (rooms, beds) divided by the number of days.

Percentage of (rooms, beds) Occupancy: (Indicator)

It is defined as the average of (rooms, beds) occupancy divided by available (rooms, beds) multiplied by one hundred.

Average Length of Stay: (Indicator)

Represents the total of guest nights by nationality divided by number of guests of the same nationality.

North of West Bank:

Jenin, Tulkarm, Nablus, Qalqiliya, Salfit and Tubas governorates.

Middle of West Bank:

Ramallah and Al-Bireh, Jericho and Al-Aghwar governorates.

Jerusalem:

Jerusalem governorate.

South of West Bank:

Bethlehem and Hebron governorates.
