



Population\* in Palestine by Governorate, 2017



### Percentage Distribution of Palestinians in the World by Country of Residence, End 2017







#### Registered Live Births in the West Bank by Month of Birth, 2015










# Unemployment Rate of Participants in Labour Force (15 Years and Above) in Palestine by Age Groups, 2017

### Percentage Distribution of Monthly Household Consumption in Jordanian Dinars (JD) in Palestine by Commodities, Service Groups and Region, 2017







# Percentage Distribution of Palestinian Population aged (15 Years and Over) in Palestine by Educational Attainment, 2017





Number of Mosques in Palestine by Governorate, 2017





#### Percentage of Households Wich have Computer Desktop by Governorate, 2017



















### Percentage Distribution of Guest Nights in the West Bank by Nationality, 2016



### Numbers of Reared Livestock (Domestic) in Palestine by Type, As on 24/03/2015








