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

- 4. Agricultural Year: starts in October of every year and ends in September of the following year.

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



Percentage Distribution of Palestinians in the World by Country of Residence, End Year 2021








Population Pyramid in Palestine, End Year 2021






Unemployment Rate of Participants in Labour Force (15 Years and over) in Palestine by Age Groups, 2021




Percentage Distribution of Persons aged (15 Years and over) in Palestine by Educational Attainment, 2020, 2021







Mortality Rates among Children Under-5, Infant and Neonatal in Palestine, 2019-2020




Continuum of Reproductive and Maternal Health Interventions by Region, 2019-2020











Value of Registered Imports, Exports in Goods and Net Trade Balance in Palestine*, 2010 - 2020








Number of Guest Nights in the West Bank by Nationality, 2020







Quantity of Water Available Annually in Palestine, 2012-2020





Percentage Distribution of Households in Palestine by Type of Housing







Percentage Distribution of Main Income Earners by Region, Sex of the Household's Main Income Earner and the Reality of Work, Palestine (June - December), 2020




Percentage Distribution of Main Income Earners by the Nature of Work, Palestine (June - December), 2020





Percentage of Households Who Needed Health Services and Managed to Reach them by Type of Health Service, Palestine (June - December), 2020







Percentage Distribution of Households by Assessment of expenditures on food supplies, Compared with the Period before COVID-19 Pandemic, Palestine (June - December), 2020






